

Haliburton Scout Reserve Rifle Range Individual Permission to Shoot

Shooting on the Haliburton Scout Reserve Rifle Range is an **optional** activity for both groups and individuals. The Scouts Canada policy regarding Rifle Range shooting requires that each Scout-aged youth (11 & older) must have signed permission from the member's parent or guardian. Therefore in order for your child to shoot at the Haliburton Scout Reserve rifle range, this permission form must be completed and returned to the leader of your group.

Only youth with signed permission forms will be permitted to shoot on the camp range.
