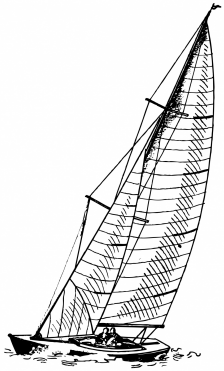


FALL 2026 NEWSLETTER
